PRAYER DECLARATION INSTRUCTIONS

It's TIME! Saturday, Nov. 9th at 8:00am LOCAL time (your time zone). The goal is to have ALL 50 states speaking this into the atmosphere. There will be a wave of declarations spoken across our nation for 6 hours!

INSTRUCTIONS:

A PEACE OFFERING in the Old Testament Law is described in <u>Leviticus 7:11–21</u>. It was a voluntary sacrifice given to God in three specific instances:

- A PEACE offering could be given as a freewill offering, meaning that the worshiper was giving the PEACE offering as a way to say thank you for God's unsought generosity. It a way to praise God for His goodness.
- A PEACE offering could be given was alongside a fulfilled vow. A good example of this was when Hannah fulfilled her vow to God by bringing Samuel to the temple; on that occasion she also brought a PEACE offering to express the peace in her heart toward God concerning her sacrifice. It was a way to say, "I have no resentment; I am holding nothing back in the payment of my vow."
- A PEACE offering was to give thanksgiving for God's deliverance in an hour of dire need.

*None of these three reasons to sacrifice had anything to do with propitiation, with appearing God, or with pacifying Him.

REMINDERS:

- 1. PRAY about where to do the Declarations the 2nd Sat. of each month. *Pray, rather than think*. God knows the best place. It could be a governmental building, but it also could be a parking lot and God knows something you do not.
- 2. These should be done OUTSIDE. We speak these into the atmosphere.
- 3. START promptly at 8:00am local time
- 4. God designed this to be simple so everyone can be involved. Therefore, we do not suggest you add anything to the 15 min time. (unless otherwise specified for the month)

A PEACE OFFERING

Father, You are **Yahweh-Shalom**, The Lord our peace.

PEACE in ISRAEL

You instructed us to "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem" that You may prosper who love Israel. "Peace be within your walls, prosperity within your palaces", O Israel (Psalm 122:6-7). We pray for peace at Israel's borders "from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates" (Exodus 23:31).

"The work of righteousness will be **peace**, And the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever. My people will dwell in a **peace**ful habitation, In secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places" (Isaiah 32:17-18).

We bless Israel in word and deed, so that all the families of the earth shall be blessed (Genesis 12:3) and so that **peace** shall come to Israel and America. **Jehovah, the God of Israel, is my peace**.

PEACE in AMERICA

Father, we pray for **peace** in the hearts of Americans, at home and abroad. We pray for the hearts of Americans to turn to Jesus for **peace**, rather than the government. As it is written, "I am for **peace**" (Psalm 120:7a). "For He Himself is our **peace**, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation" (Eph. 2:14).

"He only is my rock and my salvation, my defense; I shall not be shaken" (Psalm 62:6). "Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; for the Lord God is my strength and song, and He has become my salvation" (Isaiah 12:2). Magen, the Lord my Shield and protector, is my peace. (Magen pronounced: maw-gane)

Remind us Holy Spirit to place our trust in You and not in wealth, government, or man. Only Jesus can bring **peace** to my soul and our nation. "The Lord is my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The Lord is the defense of my life; Whom shall I dread?" (Psalm 27:1). Adonai, the Lord and Master, is my peace.

"You only are my rock and my salvation, my defense; I shall not be shaken" (Psalm 62:6). "Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; for the Lord God is my strength and song, and He has become my salvation" (Isaiah 12:2). Yahweh Elohim, the one true God, is my peace.

"David built there an altar to the Lord, and offered burnt offerings and **peace** offerings. So, the Lord heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel" (2 Samuel 24:25). Today, we offer up our **peace** offering, unto You, Yahweh, by allowing "the **peace of God** to **rule in our hearts**, to which also we are called in one body; and we will be thankful" (Colossians 3:15).

We understand that nothing can happen without either Your permission (Job 1:12) or Your direct hand in the situation. "He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings; He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding" (Daniel 2:21-22). Yahweh Sabaoth, the Lord of Host, is our peace.

Our **peace** rest in Your providence as You have set the king over America. "Dominion and fear belong to Him; He makes **peace** in His high places" (Job 25:2).

As it is written, "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have **peace**. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world" (John 16:33). "The Lord will give strength to His people; The Lord will bless His people with **peace**" (Psalm 29:11).

We speak Philippians 4 over America. "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Phil. 4:6-7).

"For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made **peace through the blood of His cross**" (Colossians 1:19-20). "He has redeemed my soul in **peace** from the battle that was against me, For there were many against me" (Psalm 55:18).

Therefore, we will "depart from evil and do good; seek **peace** and pursue it" (Psalm 34:14). We will "pursue **peace** with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord" (Hebrews 12:14), for "the fruit of righteousness is sown in **peace** by those who make **peace**" (James 3:18).

"Lord, lift up the light of Your countenance upon us. You have put gladness in my heart. I will both lie down in **peace**, and sleep; for You alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety" (Psalm 4:7a, 8). For "When a man's ways please the Lord, He makes even his enemies to be at **peace** with him" (Proverbs 16:7)

"I will hear what God the Lord will speak, For He will speak **peace** To His people and to His saints; But let them not turn back to folly. Mercy and truth have met together; Righteousness and **peace** have kissed" (Psalm 85:8, 10). "And the God of **peace** will crush Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you" (Romans 16:20). **El Elyon, the Lord Most High is my peace**.

"These are the things you shall do: Speak each man the truth to his neighbor; Give judgment in your gates for truth, justice, and **peace**" (Zechariah 8:16). "Therefore let us pursue the things which make for **peace** and the things by which one may edify another" (Romans 14:9). **El Roi, the God who sees, is my peace**.

We praise You, Abba, for hearing our petitions and for answering by giving us Righteous Rule in our nation. We will now, "Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant your petition which you have asked of Him" (1 Samuel 1:17). For "You will keep us in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because we trust in You" (Isaiah 26:3). El Shaddai, God Almighty, the all sufficient one, is my peace.
